

Post-It Pandemonium Instructions

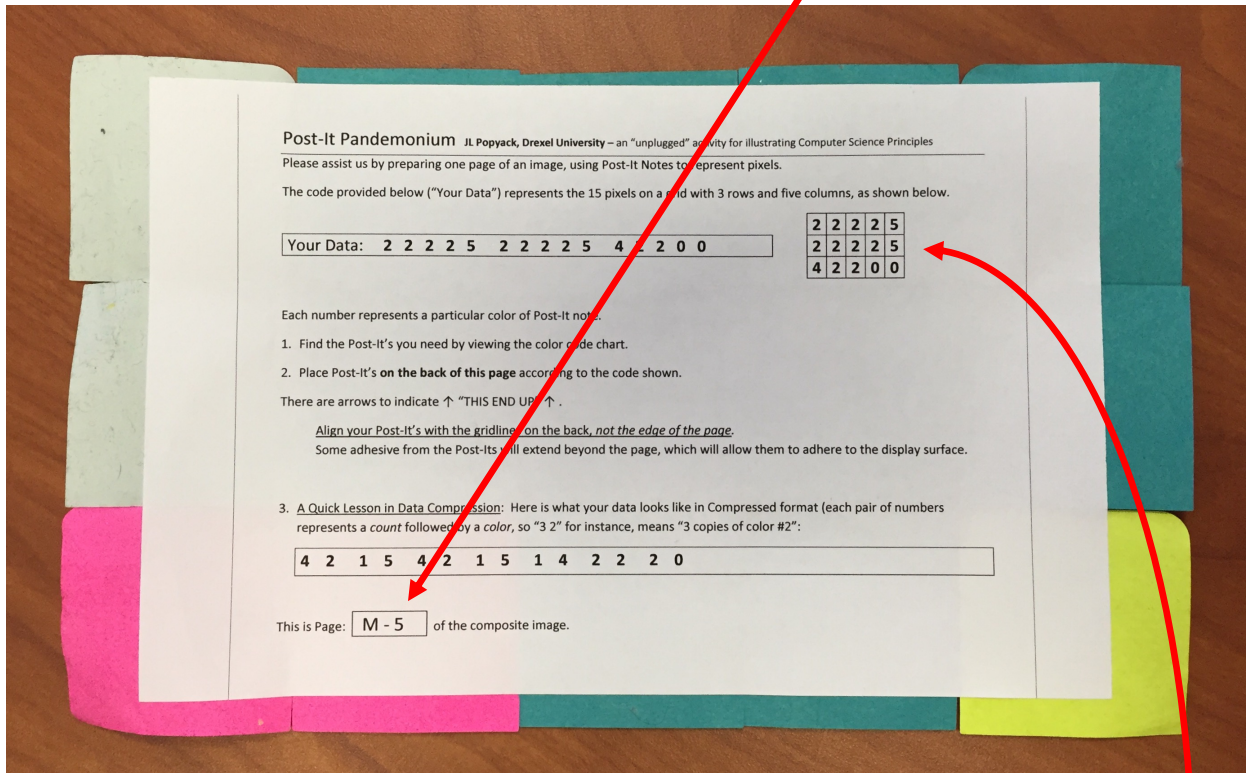

We are re-creating a GIF image, using Post-It's to represent the pixels.

1. Get a sheet with individual instructions on it. Each sheet belongs in a certain place on the big banner. Your sheet has a letter and number to show where it goes.



A sample sheet is shown below. This sheet belongs in space **M-5**:



2. Look at the Color Table to find out what color each of the numbers 0, 1, 2, ..., 7 stands for.
3. The Post-It's for your sheet are arranged according to the chart near the top-right of your sheet.
4. Put the Post-It's on the back of your sheet according to the pattern.

NOTE THAT THE POST-IT'S EXTEND OUTSIDE THE EDGES OF THE SHEET. THIS ALLOWS THE STICKY PARTS TO STICK TO THE BANNER.

5. After finishing your sheet, put in on the banner where it belongs.
